

# ***BlogLive User Manual***

## ***MOBILE BLOGGER ASSISTANT***



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## Introduction

**Bloglive** is a powerful mobile blogging application that enables you to update your online blog directly from your mobile phone. With Bloglive, updating your blog while you're on the go is as easy as writing an SMS. It runs on your smartphone and allows you to write new blog entries, publish them on your blog, and edit them afterwards or delete them. Above all these, Bloglive allows you to take photos with your smartphone's built-in camera and attach them in your posts, or upload photos stored in your smartphone to your blog.

## *Main Features*

- Supports multiple blog accounts
- Efficiently create, edit and delete posts
- User library support for frequently used words and phrases
- Advanced text editor: Easily insert text URL, online image in your posts, without having to enter any HTML codes
- Take photos with built-in camera & Upload photos stored in mobile phone
- Advanced photo editor: Easily resize and save photos in your favorite format
- Supports major online mobile systems including the Blogger, WordPress, Movable Type, TypePad, and MetaWeblog API for compatibility with a most blog sites

## ***Installing Bloglive***

There are 2 easy ways to install Bloglive. The quickest way is to directly upload "Bloglive.jar" onto your mobile device and click it to start the installation process.

If you are using a Nokia smartphone, you can install it with Nokia PC Suite, which can be downloaded from <http://europe.nokia.com/A4144903>. The instructions regarding the installing procedures can be found in the Nokia PC Suite's User Guide. This will usually require a PC and a USB data cable (or Bluetooth) between a PC and your Nokia device.

## ***With Nokia PC Suite***

The procedures to install Bloglive with the Nokia PC Suite are:

- Start the Nokia PC Suite Desktop Manager.
- Connect your Nokia device to your PC or laptop. This is usually done by connecting the USB cable or through Bluetooth (if supported.)
- Run Nokia PC Suite.



- Select "Install application".
- Select "Bloglive.jar" and follow the instructions to install Bloglive

## Running Bloglive

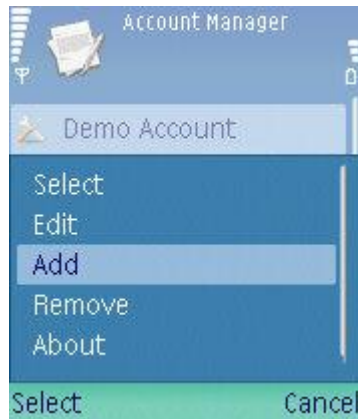
Select Bloglive icon in the main menu to start Bloglive.

### Main Window

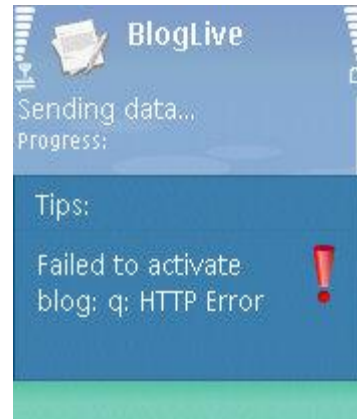


### Create Blog Account

By selecting "Add" option in the main menu of Bloglive, you can start to add your blog account into Bloglive. You will need to input the Account Name, Blog URL (the URL of your blog, i.e. <http://www.buzzermatrix.com>), User Name, Password, Blog Type (i.e. MovableType, MetaWeblog, Blogger or WordPress), and Blog Xml-Rpc URL (i.e. <http://www.buzzermatrix.com/xmlrpc.php>). If you are not sure about how to input info into the related areas, you can refer to "Demo Account" in the blog account list.



After you have filled each field with your blog's related info, you should click "Activate" option in the main menu to activate your blog. By activating your blog, Bloglive will check online and verify whether your blog is live. If your blog is live, Bloglive will notify the blog (or blog list) has been verified. You only need to select and confirm the blog to continue. Otherwise, if Bloglive finds your blog is not live any more, it will return an error message. Your blog will remain inactive until you correctly activate it.



## Blog Manager

After activating your blog, you can enter "Blog Manager". Here you can find the directories of Drafts and Published articles. You can also write a new article by selecting the "New Article" option on the list.



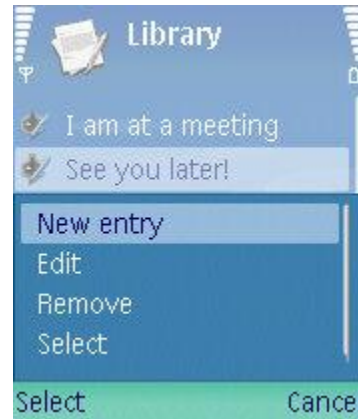
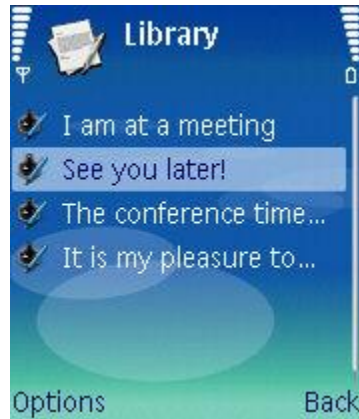
## Write Article with "Advanced Body Editor"

When you are writing the new article, you can enter text directly into the "Body" area or choose to write your article with the "Advanced Body Editor", which will offers you some advanced features including "User Library", "Text URL" and "Image URL" composer, etc.



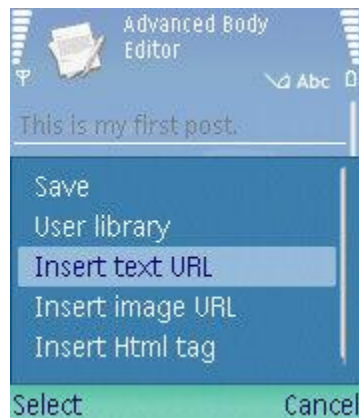
***User Library***

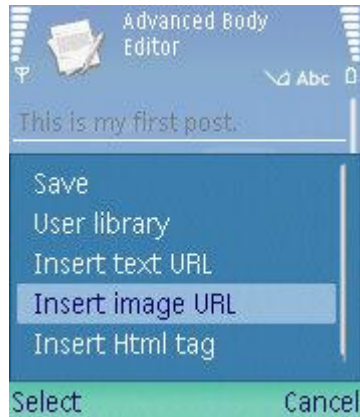
In the "User Library", you can enter and save some of your frequently used words and phrases. Then you can insert them into your article directly from the "Advanced Body Editor".



***Insert Text URL & Image URL***

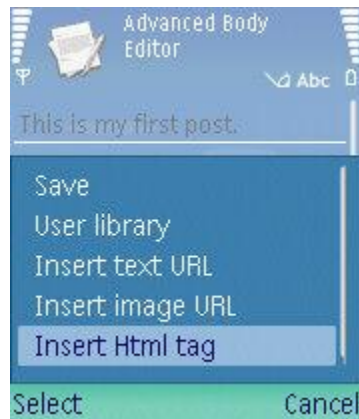
By selecting "Insert Text URL" or "Insert Image URL" option in the main menu of "Advanced Body Editor", you can quickly insert a web link or an online image into your article. Bloglive allows you to compose articles without having to enter any HTML codes





***Insert HTML tag***

Bloglive also enables you to quickly insert frequently used html tags into your article with its "Insert HTML tag" option. You can choose to enter the html tag manually or select it directly from the list.



**Add Photo into an Article**

There are two ways to add a photo into your article: upload your saved photos in your mobile phone, or capture a photo with the built-in camera

***Upload photo from mobile phone***

By clicking "Select photo" option in main menu, you can enter the file directories of your mobile phone. There you can browse and select saved photos to be inserted into the article.



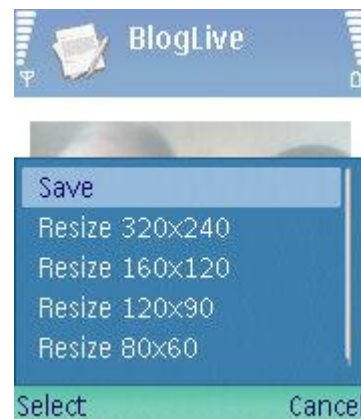
***Capture photo with built-in camera***

You can also select "Capture photo" option in main menu to launch the built-in camera. After it is taken, the picture will be automatically inserted into the article. The picture will also be saved into your mobile phone under the directory of "images/bloglive".



***Edit photo with "Advanced Photo Editor"***

After inserting a photo into the article, you can click on the "Advanced Photo Editor" to resize the photo to your desired size.



## "Draft" & "Published" Directory

### *"Draft" directory*

If you have not finish writing a new article or want to publish it later, you can save the article in the "Draft" directory. Later, you can enter the "Draft" directory and edit the article whenever you want.

### *"Published" directory*

After you have successfully published your article, the article will be moved into the "Published" directory. There you can review the article whenever you want.



By selecting the "Configure" option in menu, you can also set the maximum number of records that can be saved in "Draft" & "Published" Directory.



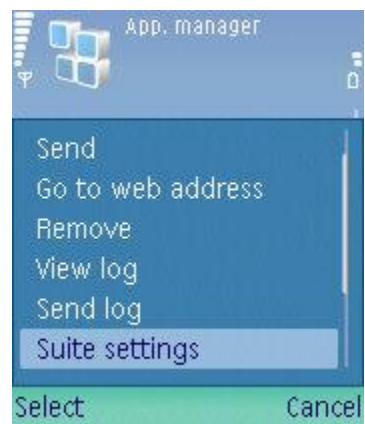
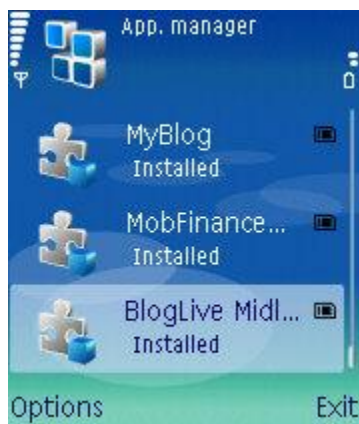
## Appendix – Midlet suite settings for Nokia Users

Bloglive is a signed midlet with Verisign's J2ME certificate. So users can adjust Bloglive's midlet suite settings by the following means to avoid a frequently jumping out windows asking for "connecting to internet" or "capture photos" authorization.

1. Enter "Tools->App. manager", select BlogLive Midlet.



2. Select the "Suite Settings" option in the main menu



3. Change the settings for "Network Access", "Multimedia", "Read User Data" and "Edit User Data" as "Always allowed"
